### Opening

1. Can you think of any sportspeople, writers, actors, musicians, artists, etc who are indisputably the greatest in their field across all time? Why is it difficult to identify genuinely Greatest Of All Time kind of figures?
2. How does the metaphor of the blind men describing the elephant illustrate the culture we live in? Is it easier to believe this so as to not cause conflict?
3. Which denial of pluralism was most significant for you
  - a. Problem of respect
  - b. Problem of truth
  - c. Problem of history
4. Do you find it challenging to stand opposed to other faiths? Would you rather just keep to yourself?
5. What comfort do you have in Jesus' death & resurrection to be the truth of your life?
6. How does Jesus' claim of absolute truth affect the way we talk to others about Jesus? *Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. John 14:6*
7. How does Jesus' exclusive claim affect the way we live now?
